

Page 6, Scoring a Feature: “is scores full points” should read “is awarded full points”

Page 7, Game End and Final Scoring: First sentence should read “The game ends as soon as a player can no longer draw and place a landscape tile.”

Page 9, Scoring with the Abbot: Add “or gardens” after “incomplete monasteries”

Page 9, Scoring with the Abbot: First sentence of second paragraph should read “On your turn, if you **do not place a meeple** during the **2. Placing a meeple** phase, you may instead return your already-placed abbot to your supply.”

Page 14, Placing a Tile and Getting a Double Turn: Third bullet point should read “During a double turn, you may perform **1. Place a tile**, **2. Place a meeple**, **3. Score a feature** in its first part, and then perform these three steps again in its second part.”

Page 14, Placing a Pig: Third paragraph should read “If your pig, due to removal of farmers (which is possible with some expansions), is left standing during the game in a field where none of your farmers are left, return it to your supply.”

Page 16, Score a Meeple and Return it to your Supply: Paragraph should read “Choose one of your meeples in the play area. If you have the majority in the feature where this meeple is, score the area as you would at the end of the game but only you get points. Then return only your meeple that was on the feature back to your supply, even if it didn’t score any points.”

Page 16, Other Rules: Final paragraph should read “**CAUTION:** Only the active player can draw messages, therefore any other players with a scoring figure landing on a scoreboard dark space do not receive messages during another player’s turn.”

Page 16, Inns & Cathedrals: “Messages 5 and 6” should read “Messages 6 and 7”

Page 17, Placing a Meeple and Ferry: Paragraph should read “After placing a lake tile, you may place a meeple on it according to the usual rules. If you choose to do it on a road, you must place the meeple on one of the three or four road ends on the lake tile. Then take a wooden ferry from the supply and place it on the lake so that it goes from one jetty at a road end to another. The ferry will now connect the ends of the road via the two jetties to form a continuous road. A jetty without ferry ends a road.”

Page 17, Extending a Road with a Ferry on it: Section should read

Extending a road with ferries and repositioning ferries

If you use a tile to extend an open road leading to a ferry, you may now (if necessary, after placing a meeple) reposition this ferry on its tile. You must connect two road ends (ending at a jetty) again. You may also move the ferry so that it no longer has a connection to the road you just extended. Starting from the tile you have placed, you may only move the **first ferry** along the road.

Special case: If the tile just placed extends several roads leading to a ferry, you may reposition the first ferry on each of these roads.

By repositioning ferries, it is possible for a road that was previously completed and scored to now be incomplete.

More rules: You may only reposition a ferry **only once** per turn. If you place a lake tile on a road with a ferry, you first place your meeple, then you place a new wooden ferry, and finally you can also reposition one or (possibly) several ferries on the roads just extended, if any.

Page 18, Placing a Tile: Add “(diagonal is allowed)” after “an adjacent tile of your choice”

Page 18, Scoring a Feature: Second paragraph should read “**In case of a tie:** If multiple players share the majority in a completed feature with gold ingots on one or more of its tiles, or if several features with gold ingots are completed at the same time and they are controlled by different players, the distribution is as follows: Starting from the active player, all players take one gold ingot to which they are entitled in clockwise order. This continues until all the gold ingots involved have been taken.”

Page 18, Scoring a Feature: Add “Players will place their gold ingots before them for the remainder of the game. The gold ingots will be scored during the final scoring.” after second paragraph

Page 20, Placing a Tile: “Then, place your robber meeple” should read “Then, you may place your robber meeple”

Page 20, Placing a Tile: Third sentence should read “Then, the next player to the left with no robber on the scoreboard is allowed to place it.”

Page 20, Placing a Tile: Last sentence of the image caption should read “Since the **blue** and **yellow** robbers are already on the scoreboard, the **green** player may now place their robber as well.”

Page 21, Crop Circle Action: Option A should read “Based on the crop circle, you **may** deploy a meeple from your supply next to one of your meeples already on a tile.”

Page 24, Place a Meeple: Abbot should be on the flying machine list
