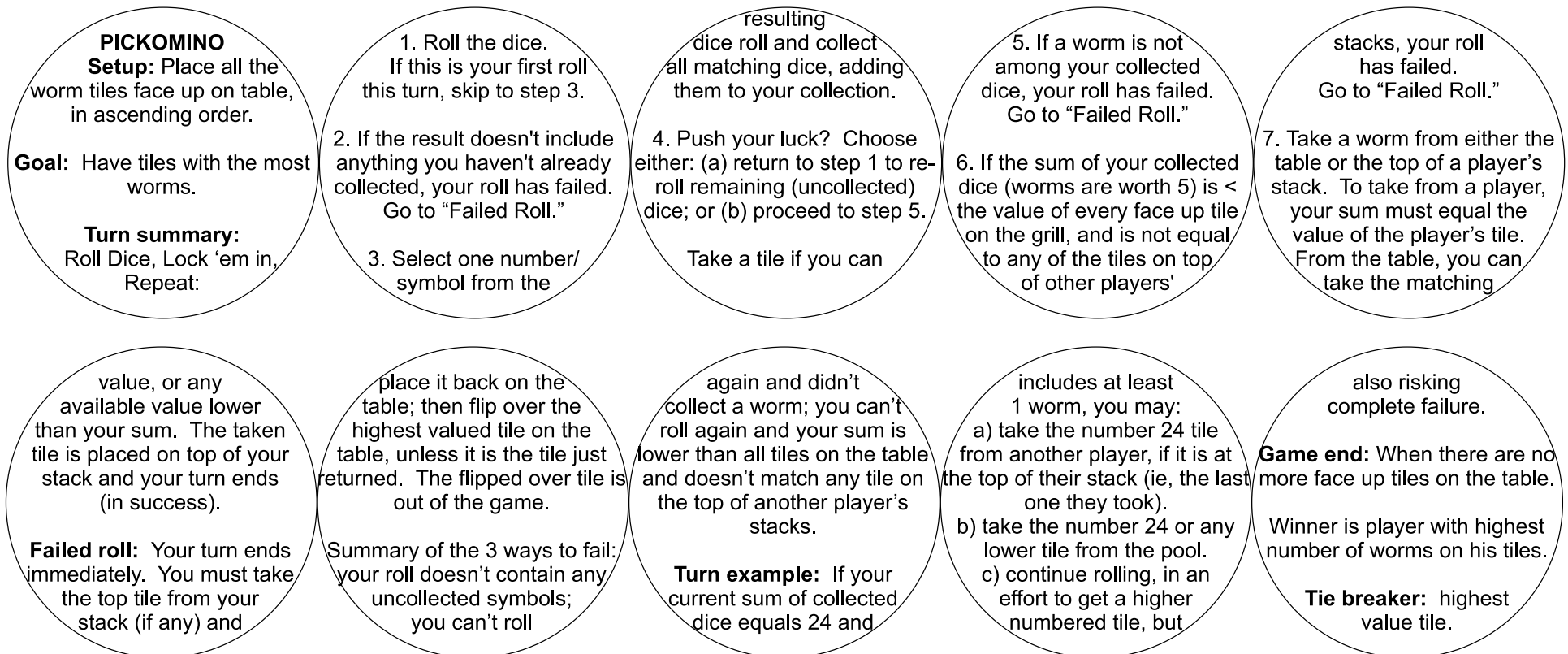




Foldable English translation of rules for mini Heck Meck (Pickonimo) in tin case:

1. Cut each row of circles separately into rectangular strips
2. Glue the two strips back-to-back (using a gluestick or rubber cement) being sure to align the circles. It helps to do this on a light table or with backlight of some kind. Note the First 'page' and the 'last' page will be back-to-back.
3. Cut out all the way around around the resulting circles. However, do NOT cut such that you separate the circles; be sure there is some material left between each pair of neighboring circles. I usually cut across a tiny bit before just before the meeting point of the circles.
4. Fold the instructions accordion style, back and forth so that the final instructions form a circle shape that should fit neatly into the Heck Meck tin case.
