

# XENON 5th PLAYER PROFITEER VARIANT

## HOW-TO:

Before playing with 5 players, print out these two sheets. They are set-up to be printed on either side of a single sheet of cardstock, but alternatively they may be printed on two separate sheets of paper and glued together. Cut them out using scissors (or a 1-inch hole punch). This will form the 5th player's Center Console and a new supply of (Xe) tokens.

You may need a few more tokens to represent extra currency during the game, any standard cube or token will do if the supply of Money runs out (money is not meant to be limited).

## RULES CHANGES:

A 5 player game is set-up and played exactly the same way as the standard rules for the game, with a few minor exceptions.

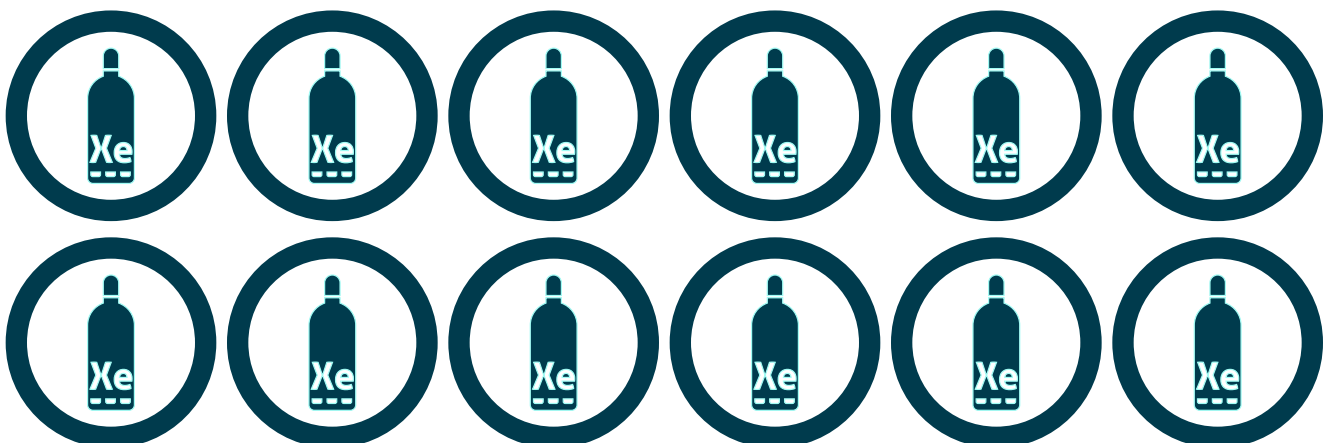
**Xenon Tokens:** The Xenon Tokens provided here are used to represent isolated (Xe) when (Xe) cards in the general supply are running low. When isolating (Xe) during Distill, simply place your (Xe) card back into the general supply and replace it with a Xenon Token. Each Xenon Token counts as a single isolated (Xe) and is used to complete contracts in the same way as (Xe) cards. Simply return them to a central pile when completing a Contract.

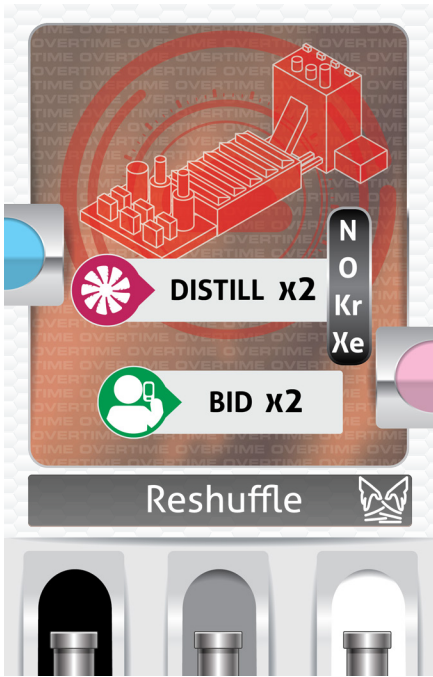
**AIR Supply:** If there is ever a situation in which an element supply stack has become empty and a player Introduces AIR, that player gains all other available Element cards and gains \$1 for each AIR action, **instead of \$2**.

If the (Xe) stack is empty, that player receives a Xenon Token instead and immediately places it on the right side of their Center Console. This counts as an isolated Xenon.

### Special Note:

*There is one Profiteer card ability that allows a player to have 10 bid tokens. If this ability is chosen, simply find 5 cubes or tokens around the house to use as these extra bid tokens.*





**Note:**

The 5th player variant was never meant to be included in the standard game. The game was designed for 2-4 players and it is highly recommended that the first game be played using those player counts.
